Gianfranco Di Vaio is **Head of Investor Relations & Rating Agencies** at **Cassa Depositi e Prestiti (CDP) Group**, the Italian National Promotional Institution controlled by the Italian Ministry of Economy and Finance, where he has previously been **Head of Research**, **Head of Macro Research** and **Senior Economist**. In his current position, he manages the relations with institutional investors and bondholders (i.e. Investment Banks; Asset Managers; Insurance Companies; Pension funds; etc.), as well as the main international credit and ESG rating agencies. He is in charge of organizing international roadshows in the major financial markets worldwide (i.e. US; Eurozone; UK; Japan; China) and is responsible for the Group financial communication.

He has a long academic experience: he qualified as **Associate Professor of Political Economy** and **Assistant Professor of Political Economy**. He is **Adjunct Professor of International Economics** at **LUISS Guido Carli** in Rome, where he taught several courses both at graduate and undergraduate level (i.e. International Economics and Industrial Dynamics; Global Economic Challenges; Global Macroeconomic Perspectives; Principles of Economics; Energy Economics; Economic Growth and Development; European Economic History and Policies; Business History and Corporate Organization). He has been **Research Fellow** at the Department of Economics, Finance and Statistics of the **University of Perugia** and at the Department of Economics of the **University College Dublin**. He visited for short-term periods the Department of Economics of **KfW**, the National Promotional Institution owned by the German Government, and the Department of Economics of the **University of Copenhagen**. He has been also **Marie Curie Fellow** of the **European Commission**.

He is member of the **Editorial Team** of the **Review of Economics and Institutions** and **Fellow** of the **Rimini Centre for Economic Analysis (RCEA)**. He has been member of the **Board of Directors** of the **Italian Association of Financial Analysts and Consultants (AIAF)** and of the **Scientific Committee** of the **Italy-ASEAN Association**. He published on peer-reviewed journals and presented his works in many international conferences. He holds a **PhD in History and Theory of Economic Development** at **LUISS Guido Carli** and a Degree in **Modern Arts** at the **University of Naples Federico II**.
