The Incoming Pluralism of Global Governance* (Palgrave 2018, with Matteo Dian). She has also been published in a variety of publications including *East Asia Forum*, *China Brief*, *AsiaMaior* and *ChinaFile*. Her research interests focus primarily on comparative regionalism and global governance, EU-Asia relations, foreign policy, think tanks and non-governmental actors of contemporary Asia (China, Japan, Korean Peninsula).
