 “South-South and Triangular Cooperation
 Sharing Experiences and Facilitating Collaborative Innovations”**

The Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) and Luiss University continue to work in partnership to increase food security through youth capacity development. To this end, FAO is supporting Luiss in the organization and undertaking of a simulation of a UN Model programme based on a FAO Council protocol. The student-delegates will explore how developing countries can collaborate to combat hunger by sharing successful policies and strategies, technological innovations, and best practices in agrifood systems. Following a comprehensive programme of online lectures to prepare the student-delegates, a Simulation will take place highlighting diversity of perspectives, encouraging dialogue on resource-sharing and mutual learning as pathways to sustainable solutions. The programme will also emphasize FAO’s role in facilitating knowledge exchange, providing technical assistance and supporting capacity building.

To prepare student-delegates for their engagement in the Simulation, a preparatory online programme, identified below, will give them a basic knowledge of:

- International environmental law
- FAO’s history and programme of work
- The concept of agrifood systems and the role of the youth
- South-South and Triangular Cooperation modalities
