### 1. Citizenship and migration studies, in relation to rule of law practices

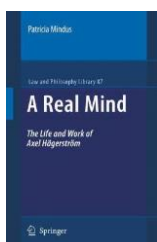

# CURRICULUM

## MASSIMO EGIDI

Massimo Egidi is Professor Emeritus at Luiss University in Rome, where teaches Behavioral Economics and Psychology. He has served as Rector of Luiss for ten years (October 2006 to October 2016). He has also served as Rector of University of Trento (from 1996 to 2004) and was President of FBK – the Bruno Kessler Foundation in Trento, serving from December 2010 to December 2014.

He is a member of the Università Italo Francese, as well as a founding member of the Ateneo Italo Tedesco. With Jean Paul Fitoussi he was co-chairman of the Herbert Simon Society and director, with Axel Leijonhufvud, of the Laboratory of Experimental and Computational Economics (CEEL, Trento). He was responsible for the National Research Programme in the sector of Economics and Social Sciences 2009-13. He is a member by right of the Scientific Committee of Confindustria. He is associate editor of *Industrial and Corporate Change*, and *Mind and Society*.

As a scholar, his main research interests are related to the study of boundedly rational behaviour in organizations and institutions. In particular, he is the author of around 100 scientific publications on topics such as behavioural economics, theory of organisation and organisational learning, and theory of decisions, under the umbrella of the scientific approach developed by Herbert Simon (Nobel prize 1980) from the 1950s onwards, which today is summarised as the “bounded rationality” approach. A parallel line is represented by the collaboration with Reinhardt Selten (Nobel prize 1994), again on themes of bounded rationality and by the research carried out in recent years in the area of Behavioral Economics.

In the framework of his academic activity, he has been invited speaker within a number of national and international conferences on issues related to university governance, relations between research and industry as well as on the European policies for technology transfer and innovation. Furthermore, he took part in the activities of the European University Association (EUA), which performs a leader role in the creation of a European space for research and training. He was the representative of the conference of Italian rectors in the EUA, authorized to speak on issues related to university governance, the relationship between industry and research, technology transfer, and research and innovation policies. Following his participation in the European debate on the reform of the university system (“Bologna process”) he is the author of publications in the field of Higher Education policies.

Christian Blasberg, born in Wuppertal (Germany), is since 2008 lecturer for Contemporary History, Comparative History of Political Systems, History of Totalitarianism and Far-Right Movements as well as History and Politics of Germany and Europe at LUISS Guido Carli University. He has been visiting professor at Université de Montreal (UdeM), teaching modules on “La démocratie et l’extrême droite dans l’Europe du XXe siècle” (“Democracy and the Extreme Right in 20th Century Europe”) and collaborated with University of Heidelberg, where he gave seminars on Germany in the 20th Century, among them “Die Geschichte der Deutschen Erinnerungskultur nach 1945” (“History of German Memory Culture after 1945”). Other fields of expertise are the History of European Federalism, Germany and European Integration, Italian liberalism in the 2. Postwar (on which he published his PhD thesis in 2008), the French extreme right in the 1930’s (topic of M.A. thesis) as well as the French IVth Republic.

After his undergraduate studies in History and Political Sciences at Universities of Heidelberg and Montpellier, he has been collaborator of the Heidelberg Institute for International Conflict Research (HIK) focussing his research on conflict assessment in the Maghreb and Balkans areas. Furthermore he has been working as a free-lance journalist. He got his PhD in 2004 at University of Heidelberg.

Prior to joining LUISS he has been a Post-doc researcher for the Fondazione Luigi Einaudi in Rome, participating in various post-doc projects on the history of Italian liberalism in the 20th Century. He also collaborated with Friedrich-Naumann-Stiftung Gumpersbach, and Hugo-Preuss-Stiftung in Berlin, Telma-University Rome and participated in international conferences, a.o. in Chemnitz, Berlin, Rome, Reading and Siena.

Fluent in English, French, Italian and German, he is an international TV, radio and press commentator for questions of international relations, European politics and German, French and Italian affairs.

After many years as a lecturer at Uptier University Rome (1999-2010), at LUISS he is currently teaching the course “Contemporary History” for the BA in Politics, Philosophy and Economics, “Comparative History of Political Systems” for the MA International Relations, Seminars for “European Politics in the 20th Century” as well as “Europe and the German Question” within the Master in European Studies (LUISS School of Government).
