

Call for applications for the awarding of scholarships in the 2026/2027 academic year reserved for students enrolled at Luiss Guido Carli in the 2025/2026 academic year.

1. Subject Matter of the Call for Applications

The education of a new generation of successful students and graduates capable of connecting different worlds through a combination of knowledge and skills is one of the objectives of our University. In order, therefore, to encourage and reward the most deserving students, according to the Decision n. 289/2026 of the Luiss Executive Committee, Luiss is offering **fifty merit-based scholarships** in the 2026/2027 academic year earmarked for students who distinguish themselves for their commitment and success in their studies.

The merit scholarship consists of exemption from payment of the **first instalment of the Single Contribution due for the 2026/2027 academic year** and is not automatically renewable for any subsequent years of the course. As the deadline for payment of the first instalment of the Single Contribution for the 2026/2027 academic year has now passed, the Luiss Offices will be responsible for reimbursing the amount already paid to the students who are awarded the partial exemption.

2. Eligibility

This competition is open to students who are duly enrolled and not off-track in a Luiss Guido Carli degree program in the 2025/2026 academic year.

Students on the ACE programme with "suspended" status in the 2025/2026 academic year during their third year of mobility at Renmin University, as per the structure of the ACE programme itself, and subject to payment of the Luiss Single Contribution in the 2026/2027 academic year, may also participate in this competition.

Excluded are students that:

- a. by 31 July 2026 have an average of less than 28/30;
- b. will not be enrolled in a Luiss Guido Carli degree program in the 2026/2027 academic year;
- c. will be enrolled as off-track students (**fuori corso**) or as repeating students in the 2026/2027 academic year;

- d. will be enrolled in a first-year master's degree program in 2026/2027 academic year and have graduated the bachelor's degree as off-track students;
- e. are enrolled in one of the Twinning Programmes/Double Degree for the Single-Cycle Degree Course in Law;
- f. while participating in the ACE programme, were enrolled in the second academic year 2025/2026 and are enrolled in the third year of the programme in the academic year 2026/2027 with the status "suspended" due to the mobility period at Renmin University.

Students, who will be attending the academic year 2026/2027 abroad as part of the following international programs, will be excluded:

- BI-Luiss Joint MSc in Marketing
- Double Master in Policies and Governance in Europe with King's College
- Double Master in International Management with King's College
- Double Degree in Social Science with Sciences Po.

3. Incompatibility

The benefit envisaged by this competition is incompatible with other tuition fee waivers or scholarships held for any reason whatsoever, except for those awarded by Italian or foreign institutions designed to support, through periods abroad, a student's education for the academic years covered by this competition.

4. Awarding of the Benefit

The ranking for the awarding of scholarships will be compiled on the basis of the score assigned to each candidate and calculated using the following formula:

$$(C/CM) + M$$

Where:

M = weighted average grade of the examinations - calculated without any rounding - passed by 31 July 2026 by the candidate for the purposes of obtaining their degree, regardless of the year of attendance, excluding excess examinations.

C = the number of credits earned by the candidate for the purposes of obtaining their degree and officially recorded by 31 July 2026, regardless of the year of attendance, excluding excess examinations. The credits earned in excess respect to the number of credits that can be earned by the candidate for the purposes of obtaining their degree will be evaluated at 50%.

CM = the total number of credits that can be earned by the candidate for the purposes of obtaining their degree, as defined in Annex to this Call for Applications, of which it is an integral part.

In the event of a tie, the order in the ranking will be determined by the highest average and, subsequently, by the ratio between the credits obtained and the credits prescribed by the student's study



plan, rounded to the fourth decimal place. In the event of a further tie, priority will be given to the date of submission of the application.

For students who will enroll in the first year of a master's degree program for the 2026/2027 academic year, the academic record and the study plan of the bachelor's degree program will be taken into consideration for the purposes of the ranking.

Students who participated in a study abroad program in the 2025/2026 academic year must indicate on the application form any exams taken abroad by 31 July 2026 (name, credits, and date of exam) **if not yet officially included in their academic record by the deadline for this competition.**

The ranking will be validated by a Committee composed of the Deputy Rector for Education and Dean Undergraduate School, the Deputy Rector for Education and Dean Graduate School and the Deputy Rector for Rankings, Accreditations and Quality. The ranking will be published by November 2026.

5. Submission of Applications

The application to participate in this competition must be submitted via the online form available on the Luiss Financial Aid webpage, **from 12:00PM (noon, Italian time) on 8 September until 12:00PM (noon, Italian time) on 30 September 2026.**

Upon online submission of the application, students will receive confirmation of receipt of the application at the e-mail address specified in the application itself.

Only complete applications actually received by the deadline will be considered.

Luiss Guido Carli disclaims any liability in relation to applications that are not received due to technical issues or reasons attributable to third parties.

6. Revocation

The benefit envisaged by this competition will be revoked upon the occurrence of any one of the following:

- a. the student fails to enroll at Luiss Guido Carli for the 2026/2027 academic year;
- b. the student discontinues her/his studies.
- c. the student transfers to another university.
- d. in the event of false statements, which may be checked by Luiss even after publication of the ranking.
- e. allocation of another scholarship, which financial benefit has a total higher amount than the financial benefit allocated with the present competition.



- f. The student does not respect any regulation or directive of the following Luiss codes: the “Code of ethics” and the “Code of Conduct for the Prevention and Combating of Discrimination, Bullying and Sexual Harassment”
