

Call for Applications for the 2026/2027 Academic Year **Luiss University Halls of Residence** **Renewal of 2025/2026 Accommodation Allocations**

1. Luiss University Halls of Residences

The university halls of residence at which accommodation places can be applied for are as follows:

- **Residenza Vajna**, Via Eugenio Vajna 12, Rome
- **Residenza Lisbona**, Via di Lisbona 7, Rome
- **Residenza Maria Teresa Panunzi**, Via di Santa Costanza 53, Rome
- **Residenza Pola**, Viale Pola 15, Rome
- **Residenza Villa Betania**, Via Antelao 14, Rome
- **Collegio Universitario di Merito Don Nicola Mazza ‘Giuseppe Tovini’**, Via di Trasona 56, Rome

2. Who can apply

The competition is open to students who:

- are out-of-town students;
- were allocated accommodation at the University’s halls of residence for the 2025/2026 academic year;
- have stayed at the University’s halls of residence for at least 30 consecutive days as of the competition deadline; and
- meet the merit requirements set out in point 4 below.

The competition is not open to students who:

- in the 2026/2027 academic year will be enrolled as off-track (**fuori corso**) for more than one year in their degree programme;
- have received at least one written warning.

The following students are considered as out-of-town (**fuori sede**):

- those residing in municipalities in the Lazio region more than 50 km from Rome;
- those residing in other Italian regions;
- those residing abroad.

3. Submission of Applications

Applications must necessarily be submitted **by 7 May 2026** exclusively via the online form available on the “Halls of Residence and Accommodation” webpage.

Once their application has been submitted, applicants will receive a confirmation e-mail. If the confirmation e-mail is not received, applicants should contact the Accommodation Office (housing@luiss.it – 06 85225971).

Only complete applications actually received by the deadline will be considered. Luiss University disclaims any liability in relation to applications that are not received due to reasons attributable to third parties.

4. Merit Requirements

Accommodation for the 2026/2027 academic year may be allocated to students who, by the end of the winter session of official exams for the 2025/2026 academic year, meet the following merit requirements:

- **weighted average** $\geq 26/30$

- **ECTS credits**
 - students enrolled in the first year of their degree programme in the 2025/2026 academic year: at least 60% of the required credits (Annex A)
 - students enrolled in the second or subsequent year of their degree programme in the 2025/2026 academic year: at least 70% of the required credits (Annex A)

Credits are rounded down.

Students with a certified disability of $\geq 66\%$:

- **weighted average** $\geq 25/30$
- **ECTS Credits:** 50% of the total credits (Annex A)

For the purposes of calculating fulfilment of the above requirements:

- all exams required to be awarded the degree are taken into account;
- exams over and above those required to be awarded the degree are not taken into account.

5. Rankings

The rankings will be calculated using the formula: $(M \times C) / CM$

Where:

- **M** = the weighted average of the exams passed
- **C** = the number of ECTS credits earned by the winter session of official exams for the 2025/2026 academic year
- **CM** = the total number of ECTS credits set for each degree programme and year of attendance (Annex A)

For applicants with a certified disability of $\geq 66\%$, the CM parameter is reduced by 30% (rounded down). For applicants repeating a year, the credits from the year of initial enrolment are taken into account.

Students who **have NOT been allocated a place** may participate in the booking sessions provided for in the call for applications relating to “New Allocations of Accommodation” and intended also for students enrolled in the second or subsequent years of their degree programme provided that they meet the merit requirements set out in that call for applications as of the date of submission of their application and therefore also including the results of the summer session of official exams for the 2025/2026 academic year.

6. Allocation Period

Accommodation is allocated from **1 September 2026 to 26 June 2027**. At the end of that period, the premises must be vacated and left completely free from personal effects.

6.1 Study Abroad Programme

Students who have been allocated accommodation but who will be participating in a study abroad programme must inform the Accommodation Office of the period of absence by and no later than 30 June 2026.

Based on that notification, the allocation of accommodation will be suspended for the following periods:

- 1st semester: 1 September 2026 - 28 January 2027
- 2nd semester: 1 February 2027 - 26 June 2027
- Full academic year: 1 September 2026 - 26 June 2027

Failure by students participating in a study abroad programme to notify the Accommodation Office will mean that the students concerned will be liable for payment of their entire annual rent (September 2026 - June 2027).

7.1 Payment Terms

The 10 monthly instalments must be paid in **5 advance bi-monthly instalments**. Any alternative payment methods will be promptly communicated by the relevant office.

Instalment due dates:

- September-October instalment: 5 September 2026
- November-December instalment: 5 November 2026
- January-February: 5 January 2027
- March-April: 5 March 2027
- May-June: 5 May 2027

The instalments are due in full even if the student awarded a place only takes up possession of the accommodation in question on a date after 1 September 2026.

7.2 Reduced Rates (50%)

Two places at each hall of residence will be allocated **at a reduced rate of 50%**. To that end, allocation of accommodation at a reduced rate is restricted to applicants with an **ISEE (Indicatore della Situazione Economica Equivalente) means test certificate ≤ € 25,000**. A valid ISEE certificate must be attached at the time of application.

The reduced rate accommodation is allocated:

- among the successful applicants for accommodation, and this those who have already obtained a place;
- in ascending order of ISEE score;
- with a separate ranking for each hall of residence.

8. Services Included

The rent includes:

- supply of a mattress, pillow, bedspread and blanket
- supply and weekly change of bed linen
- weekly cleaning of the room/apartment
- utilities (Wi-Fi, electricity, heating and water)
- emergency technical support
- 24-hour on-call service
- use of communal areas

Additional services included (Collegio Universitario di Merito Don Nicola Mazza only):

- internal canteen (dinner Monday-Friday; lunch and dinner on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays)
- small internal gym
- participation in some of the educational activities that form part of the personal education programme

9. Allocation of Accommodation

Accommodation is allocated:

- in order of ranking;
- subject to availability;
- taking into account the preferences expressed in the application form.

The type of room allocated and duly accepted **cannot be changed**, even if further places become available at a later date.

Allocation of accommodation is subject to duly enrolling in a degree programme at Luiss University for the 2026/2027 academic year.

For the entire period during which a student is a resident of a hall of residence, changing rooms is not permitted. However, the University reserves the right to transfer the student, including during the academic year, to another room or to another accommodation facility at the rate applicable to the new location.

9.1 Allocation of Accommodation at Collegio Universitario di Merito Don Nicola Mazza

The allocation of accommodation to eligible students at Collegio Universitario di Merito Don Nicola Mazza ‘Giuseppe Tovini’ is subject to an assessment of suitability carried out by that institution’s management. In the event of admission to that institution, the awardee of the accommodation must undertake to comply with the College’s regulations and participate in its education program (www.collegiomazza.it), compliance with which will be the basis for possible renewal of the accommodation in future years.

9.2 Forfeiture of Accommodation

Students will forfeit their entitlement to allocated accommodation, which they must then vacate within 15 days, in the event of:

- graduation;
- discontinuance of their studies;
- transfer to another university;
- the occurrence of any of the conditions set out in the General Regulations.

10. Acceptance

To confirm their accommodation place, by the deadlines to be specified when the results are published, the students concerned must fill out and submit the appropriate online acceptance form.

The security deposit of € 500 already paid for the 2025/2026 academic year will be rolled over to and remain valid for the 2026/2027 academic year. That security deposit will not be refunded to any students who renounce the place that they have been allocated after formal acceptance thereof, including where the students have never even set foot in the accommodation in question.

By accepting the accommodation, **students undertake to comply with the General Regulations of Luiss University Halls of Residence a.y. 2026/2027.**

Acceptance is subject to duly enrolling in a degree programme at Luiss University for the 2026/2027 academic year.
