



## Call For Applications Orientation 4 Summer School Admission Test valid for enrollment to the Bachelor's and Single-Cycle Master's Degree Courses for the 2027/2028 academic year

Students enrolled in the 2026 edition of the Orientation 4 Summer School who have attended the corresponding week of the 2026 edition of the Luiss Summer School, with a maximum of one absence in accordance with the Summer School Regulations, will be able to take the Admission Test valid for admission to the Bachelor's and Single-Cycle Master's Degree Courses for the 2027/2028 academic year. The Degree Courses comprise:

### Degree Courses in Italian Degree Courses in English

Economia e management	Business Administration

The test is reserved for:

- students who in the 2025/2026 academic year will have completed the penultimate year of upper secondary school under the Italian system;
- or
- students who, in the 2026/2027 academic year, will obtain by July 2027 a foreign secondary school qualification valid for enrollment in Italian universities on the basis of the ministerial guidelines set out [on the following page](#) of the University website.

Taking or passing the admission test does not imply the assessment of the secondary school qualification, which will be carried out by the University only during the enrollment phase on the basis of the requirements set out in the ministerial guidelines.

### Admission test date

The admission test will be held at the end of the week of attendance on the following dates:

- Friday 12 June 2026
- Friday 19 June 2026
- Friday 26 June 2026
- Friday 3 July 2026



- Friday 10 July 2026
- Friday 17 July 2026
- Friday 24 July 2026
- Friday 4 September 2026

The admission test can only be taken once during the 2026 edition of the Orientation 4 Summer School.

#### **Registration for the Test: procedures and deadlines**

Students must submit their application within the indicated timeframe by accessing the dedicated page that will be displayed on the University website. The test does not entail any additional cost beyond the registration fee already paid for participation in the 2026 edition of the Orientation 4 Summer School.

**When completing the application form, in addition to their personal details, candidates must provide information about their study qualifications and the language of the test, which is binding for the purposes of taking the exam, admission and subsequent enrollment.**

Students who take the test in English and pass the admission test will be able to choose to enroll in both the Degree Courses taught in Italian and those taught in English. Students who take the test in Italian and pass the admission test will be able to choose to enroll only for the Degree Courses taught in Italian. It is not necessary to submit any language certification to prove knowledge of the language.

Students will also be asked to express a preference among the Degree Courses offered, which **is not binding for admission purposes.**

Documents or information required to complete the online application (in PDF or image format):

- valid identity document of the applicant;
- where in possession, the certificate attesting the score of the Orientation 3 Summer School Test reserved for students in the third-to-last year of secondary school who attended the 2025 edition, for the purpose of the possible award of bonus points.
- where in possession, the certification attesting to Specific Learning Difficulties or temporary or permanent disability issued after 2023 for the purpose of requesting access to any compensatory measures expressly provided for by the relevant law.

#### **Admission Test**

There is only one admission test. The test lasts 75 minutes and consists of 50 multiple-choice questions, from which only one answer must be selected. The questions, of a psycho-aptitude and problem-solving nature, will be aimed at measuring reasoning skills and acquired knowledge. The test can only be taken on the Friday of the OR4 Summer School week attended.

The admission test to Degree Courses taught in English is the English translation of the Italian test. The test can only be taken once.



When the test is marked, each correct answer has a value of 1 (one). For each incorrect answer, a penalty of -0.25 (minus zero point two five) is applied, while multiple and/or unanswered questions are given a value of 0 (zero).

#### **Notice and duration**

The Admission Test will start at the time that will be communicated during the Summer School; to complete the registration procedures, candidates are asked to be present on site at least 45 minutes before the start of the session. Punctuality is therefore highly recommended.

**The use of mobile phones, any mobile device, calculators and any other technological or paper aid or tool, including headphones/earphones, smartwatches and tablets, is prohibited, under penalty of exclusion of the candidate from the test, regardless of the score obtained. It is not permitted to interact with other people for the entire duration of the test.**

The University reserves the right to change the dates, times and location of the admission test for logistical reasons.

#### **Additional points for passing the Orientation 3 Summer School Test reserved for students in the third-to-last year of secondary school who attended the 2025 edition**

Students who have successfully passed the Orientation 3 Summer School Test will be able to benefit from a bonus score of up to a maximum of 10 points on the final Test score, as detailed below:

<b>OR3 Test 2025 edition score</b>	<b>Additional points in the OR4 Test 2026 edition</b>
Between 70.00 and 79.99	+5 points
Between 80.00 and 100.00	+10 points

To obtain the bonus, candidates must select the appropriate box on the application form for the OR4 test and upload the certificate with the relevant score obtained. In the event of a discrepancy between what is declared and what is recorded in the documents, the latter shall prevail.

#### **Candidates with disabilities or Specific Learning Difficulties**

Candidates with disabilities, including temporary ones, or with SLDs must indicate their needs following the modalities outlined below, strictly when completing the application, so that Luiss Guido Carli and the appointed Committee, after verifying the documentation, can guarantee access to the compensatory measures provided for the proper conduct of the Admission Test.

When completing the application, the candidate must upload to the platform the medical documentation issued by the local health authority of residence or by facilities accredited by the Italian National Health Service and request the compensatory measures provided for by law and by this Call for Applications. The diagnosis of SLD must have been issued no more than 3 years ago, or after the age of 18, by local health facilities or by bodies or professionals accredited with



the regional health service. Please note that if the indicated deadlines are not met, it will not be possible to process the request.

In the case of a Specific Learning Difficulties (SLD) proven by appropriate medical documentation, the appointed Committee will assess the compensatory measures to be offered during the Test; one or more measures may be granted in accordance with the relevant legislation in force:

1. additional time equal to 30% of the standard test duration;
2. the use of a non-scientific calculator, to be arranged independently by the candidate;
3. the assistance of a tutor to help read the Test.

In the case of medical documentation certifying a disability of 66% or more, the appointed Committee will assess the compensatory measures to be offered during the Test; one or more measures may be granted in accordance with the relevant legislation in force:

1. additional time equal to 50% of the standard test duration;
2. the use of a non-scientific calculator, to be arranged independently by the candidate;
3. the assistance of a tutor to help enter the answers and/or read the Test.

The candidate will be notified of the outcome of the assessment by the appointed Committee by email to the address indicated in the application in good time for participation in the Admission Test and must provide a reply, indicating acceptance and the compensatory measures they intend to use.

### **Criteria di Ammissione**

The rankings will be determined 100% by the test score, expressed in hundredths, including any additional OR3 bonus points. Candidates who have obtained a score equal to or higher than **60/100** are considered admitted. Candidates will be able to consult the procedures for checking the results of the Admission Test directly on the Luiss website **from the second half of September 2026**.

Students who are not admitted will be able to repeat the test in the subsequent sessions scheduled for admission to the 2027/2028 academic year; the procedures, criteria and timing of the subsequent sessions will be published on the University website in October 2026. Please note that no bonuses or additional scores resulting from participation in the Orientation 4 Summer School 2026 edition will be awarded when taking subsequent tests.

Admission must be considered as "conditional admission" and will only be formalized after the secondary school qualification has been obtained and verified. The payment of the fee and participation in the Orientation 4 Summer School do not entail verification of the validity of qualifications; these will only be assessed at the time of enrollment and must comply with the relevant regulations in force.

### **Booking and enrollment**



Admitted students must book their enrollment by 12 November 2026, following the instructions that will be sent by email in October 2026. When booking their enrollment, students must choose the Degree Course they intend to enroll in and pay the fee corresponding to the first instalment of the annual single tuition fee for the 2027/2028 academic year, as published on the University website at the end of September 2026.

Please note that admission refers exclusively to the 2027/2028 academic year and cannot be considered valid for subsequent or previous years.

Students who have successfully booked their enrollment, subject to obtaining a suitable qualification, must complete it through an online procedure, using the methods and within the timeframes that will be communicated to candidates by email in June 2027 and published on the University website on the dedicated page, paying the regional tax and stamp duty.

Please note that, based on the provision contained in Article 27 of Royal Decree No. 1269/38, "A student who has obtained enrollment in a year of a university course is not entitled, under any circumstances, to a refund of the fees, surcharges and contributions paid".

#### **Changing the chosen course**

**By no later than 5 March 2027**, students may request to change the Degree Course chosen, in accordance with the language in which the Summer School Test was taken. The change must be requested by email to [ammissione@luiss.it](mailto:ammissione@luiss.it) within the stipulated timeframe, attaching a copy of an identity document. After that date, changing the Degree Course will only be possible after passing one of the selection processes that may be required for admission to a new Degree Course.

#### **Withdrawal of enrollment booking and refund of the instalment paid**

Students who do not intend to complete enrollment for the 2027/2028 academic year may cancel the enrollment booking made and submit a request for a refund of the first instalment paid **by no later than 5 March 2027**. The request for a refund, which must be sent by email to [ammissione@luiss.it](mailto:ammissione@luiss.it), must be accompanied by a copy of the candidate's identity document. The withdrawal request is irrevocable.

#### **Processing of Personal Data**
