



## Call for Faculty Exchange Program with Sciences Po Outgoing Luiss Faculty – 2026/2027 Academic Year

As part of the cooperation agreement in place between Luiss University and [Sciences Po](#) and within the framework of the Faculty Exchange Program, Luiss is pleased to offer its Faculty Members the opportunity to undertake a short-term mobility period at our partner institution Sciences Po.

### General Information

The Faculty Exchange Program is a reciprocal mobility scheme that allows Faculty Members from both institutions to spend a visiting period at the partner university to carry out research and teaching activities.

Through this call for applications Luiss will select its own Faculty Member(s) to participate in the exchange.

Starting from the upcoming academic year (2026/2027) two mobility options are available:

1. Two Faculty Members, each carrying out 4 weeks of mobility (either consecutive or split into two periods of two weeks), with a €4,000 gross all-inclusive lump-sum provided by the hosting institution.  
Or
2. One Faculty Member, carrying out 8 weeks of mobility (either consecutive or split into two periods of four weeks), with a €8,000 gross all-inclusive lump-sum provided by the hosting institution.

Applicants may indicate their preferred option in the application form. However, the final allocation will be determined by the Evaluation Committee, taking into consideration the candidates' preferences, the content of the applications and the overall number of applications.

For clarity, Sciences Po will independently conduct its own selection procedure and may choose between the same two options, regardless of the choice made by Luiss.

- Application Form
- Curriculum Vitae

- Declaration of interest (email or letter) from the relevant department/school/laboratory or from the Faculty Member at Sciences Po willing to host the applicant, including the proposed mobility dates

Deadline for Applications: Friday, June 26, 2026, at 5.00pm (CET)

#### **Evaluation Committee, Outcomes and Selection Criteria**

The Evaluation Committee is composed of:

- Deputy Rector for Internationalisation
- Director of Academic Affairs
- Head of International Development, Alliances & Mobility

All Candidates will be notified of the results by **July 17, 2026**, via email from [faculty mobility@luiss.it](mailto:faculty mobility@luiss.it).

Provided that all required documents have been submitted, the Committee will evaluate applications—at its sole and unquestionable discretion—based on:

- The proposed research and teaching activities
- The candidate's CV

The Committee will also give positive consideration to applications from Faculty Members who have **not previously participated** in this specific mobility program.

#### **Important Deadlines and Dates**

- Application deadline: June 26, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. (Italian local time)
- Notification of results by July 17, 2026
- Mobility period: 2026/2027 Academic Year (exact dates must be agreed with the hosting unit at Sciences Po and included in the declaration of interest)

#### **Protection of Personal Data**
