2. General Rules

Selected students will have the possibility to attend courses at the partner university during the mobility and have the credits recognized on their Luiss career at the end of the fifth year. If compliant with both universities' rules and conditions, as for credits envisaged, attendance, deadlines, academic integrity, etc., participating students will obtain the above-mentioned title on top of their Luiss Single Cycle Master's Degree in Law.

Selected students will spend abroad the 5th year of their Single Cycle Master's Degree in Law during the a. y. 2026-27 and will be registered at Luiss during their stay at the partner university. Students will continue paying tuition fees to Luiss. Depending on the program, students may be required to pay additional tuition fees at the partner university (as specified in paragraph [3. Available Slots and Fees](#)).

Selected students must be regularly enrolled in the 5th year at Luiss during the a. y. 2026-27, they may attend the first available graduation session in July 2027, if in compliance with the deadlines of the LL.M. for which they are selected, and they cannot ask for an early graduation during the a.y. 2026-27. More information on the thesis and graduation for students selected for the LL.M. Educational Program are available in the relative study plans.

All expenses related to the participation in the program, notably transport, accommodation and food, administrative expenses, expenses associated with securing a visa, medical/health/accident insurance, books and personal expenses, will be borne by students. Furthermore, students must comply with all the regulations of both universities (sending and receiving) in order to obtain the two Degrees.

Selected students are required to read and understand the study plan and its rules. These are to be considered binding to the successful completion of the program. Once selected, students are required to carefully read and sign the document "General Understanding on Mobility for LL.M. students".

Exams passed at the partner university during the mobility period will be transferred to the Luiss career according to the program study plan. It is not possible to request an official renounce of the grades' registration.

Students will be able to participate only if they have no pending administrative issues with Luiss.

While every effort will be made to provide students with complete, accurate and timely information, Luiss reserves the right to change, amend, modify or revoke the programs. Luiss is not responsible for any cancellation or modification due to events beyond its control. If the program is cancelled or modified for these reasons, Luiss will inform all interested students in a timely manner.

4. Requirements and Selection

Eligible students can apply if they comply with the requirements for each LL.M. EP they intend to apply to, specified in the [Appendix 1: Requirements](#) of this document. The applications that do not comply with the requirements specified in the [Appendix 1](#) will not be considered.

An Academic Commission nominated by the Dean of the Undergraduate School will select students on the basis of a non-disputable evaluation.

The selection follows a 3-step process:

Step 1: The eligible candidates will be ranked after the analysis of their academic performance (credits 53%, credits for internship 2%, weighted average grade 45%). The Academic Commission will rank

eligible students and create the short list for the next step. The academic performance will be calculated on the basis of the data available to the Student Office **by 12 February 2026**.¹

Step 2: An in-person interview² will be carried out by the Academic Commission and by International Degree Programs on **18 February 2026**. The interview will focus on the motivation, the academic background and the previous international and/or professional experiences. It is a key part of the selection process: in case a candidate is not considered suitable for the program, he or she will not be selected regardless of the academic performance, the positioning in the applicants' ranking and the number of available slots.

Step 3: The partner Universities will receive from Luiss the short list of candidates already ranked by the Luiss Commission with their dossier. The partner Universities, analysing the Luiss Commission ranking and the candidates' dossiers, have the right to establish the final ranking.

5. Application Procedure

Applications can be submitted **from 8 January until 21 January 2026 at 12:00 PM CET (midday)**. In order to apply, students must complete the application form and upload the required attachments in the web self-service area of the Luiss website³. Only applications accompanied by all documentation and received by the application deadline will be considered.

In case of doubts about the documents to upload or to get further information about the requested documents, students are invited to contact International Degree Programs (international@luiss.it) before the application deadline.

Students that might require special provisions during the mobility are invited to get in contact with International Degree Programs before applying to the program. International Degree Programs reserves the right to request further details or documents to applicants.

¹ Only for Luiss students who take part in an international mobility program during the 1st semester of the a. y. 2025-26 for whom the grades have not yet been registered into their student careers: the average grade will be based on the data available to the Student Office by 12 February 2026. The number of credits will be based on the additional documents provided in the application (please see [Appendix 2](#) for further details).

6. Compatibility with Other International Programs

6.1 Compatibility among the LL.M. Programs

Eligible students are allowed to apply from a minimum of one (1) to a maximum of five (5) LL.M. Programs among those included in this Call for Applications and will rank the programs according to their preferences. We strongly encourage applicants to apply only for the programs they have a real interest in and for which all requirements are met.

Students will be selected for only one LL.M. Program within their list of preferences and will be removed from the selection procedures of the other LL.M. Programs.

Students who are not selected for any LL.M. Program can remain in the waiting list of more than one LL.M. Program. If they are recalled from the waiting list of any program (regardless of their preference) and they confirm their participation, they will be subsequently removed from the other waiting lists.

If an error has occurred in the ranking of the preferences, applicants are required to flag it as soon as possible via email to International Degree Programs and in any case no later than 30 January 2026. Please note that the request will be reviewed and evaluated, and as a result, approval is not guaranteed.

Refusal or missing confirmation of the LL.M. Program selection implies the official withdrawal from all the LL.M. Programs in this Call.

6.2 Compatibility with the International Student Exchange Program

Eligible students are allowed to apply to these programs and the International Student Exchange program.

Students applying to both Calls who will be selected for the LL.M. Program must confirm their participation to the program within the established deadline as detailed in paragraph [8. Acceptance](#).

If selected students confirm their participation to the LL.M. Program, they will be automatically excluded from the selection for the International Student Exchange program and will be removed from the candidates' list.

If selected students do not confirm their participation to the LL.M. Program according to the rules explained in paragraph [8. Acceptance](#), they will remain eligible for the International Student Exchange program.

Students who completed an International Student Exchange program during previous years are eligible to apply to this Call.

6.3 Compatibility with ENGAGE.EU Program

Please note that participation in the LL.M. Educational Program may not be compatible with certain ENGAGE.EU mobility opportunities. Students who are interested in both options are strongly advised to carefully review the academic calendars and consult the ENGAGE.EU Office (engage.eu@luiss.it) for confirmation before applying.

6.4 Privacy Notice

We encourage all applicants to review the [Appendix 4](#), which includes important information about the privacy notice. Understanding these guidelines will help you stay informed about how your data is handled and protected throughout your studies.

7. Communication of results

In compliance with current provisions on personal data protection, rankings will not be published. Students will be informed of the result of their own application only. Information such as other candidates' position in the ranking will not be disclosed. Selected students will receive the communication via-email **by 20 February 2026** (date may be subject to change) on their Luiss student e-mail account. Thus, students are strongly invited to check their Luiss email account every day while the selections are ongoing.

8. Acceptance

Selected students will be required to confirm their acceptance through written notification within one working day from the communication of results.

In case of refusal or missing notification by the deadline, the following candidate in order of waiting list will be recalled. Recalled students will be required to confirm their participation by written notice within one working day.

Any refusal submitted after a candidate has accepted the offer for a slot will be forwarded to the Deputy Rector for Rankings, Accreditations and Quality, who, in collaboration with the Deputy Rector for Education and Dean of the Undergraduate School and the Director of Academic Affairs, will assess the

justification provided. Refusals deemed inadequately justified will be reported to the Graduation Commission.

9. Additional Points

The participation and successful completion of the LL.M. Program will provide additional points to the Final Grade of the Master's Degree, according to [Luiss rules](#).

3. A 300-word motivation letter for each partner university selected. Candidates must state how their own interests are linked to each program. These statements should include the academic background, reasons for applying for each program and what you hope to gain from them, including any relevant experience, strengths, ambitions or research interests. The document will be evaluated and not submitting good quality statements might cause the exclusion from these programs. All personal statements need to be uploaded **in a single PDF document** on Web Self Service;
4. ID Card or Passport, depending on the entry requirement for the selected destination⁶;
5. Other certificates (optional).

Only for Luiss students taking part in an international mobility program (Erasmus, Exchange) during the 1st semester of the a. y. 2025-2026 for whom the grades have not yet been registered into their Luiss careers:

6. Learning Agreement indicating the courses attended at the partner university and the recognition in the Luiss student career;
7. Transcript of Records or Screenshot of the academic record from the partner university's official platform. The document must clearly display all exams officially passed during the mobility program, with credits and grades. Self-prepared documents will not be accepted.

These documents will be used for this selection process only. For the formal recognition of credits and grades into the Luiss student career please refer to the relevant procedure.

Please note that selected students might need to submit to the partner university two recommendation letters for the destination they have been selected by the deadline of **early/mid March 2026**. This is a requirement of the partner university.

⁵ Students who are waiting for English language certificate results may submit a self-declaration by the application deadline (21 January 2026) but are required to send the official certificate by email to the International Degree Programs by 12 February 2026.

⁶ Students commit to renew their passport should the expiration date not cover the whole mobility period and depending on the partner university's requests.

How does the Controller process your personal data and how long is the data stored for?

The data subject's personal data are processed both on paper and electronically (servers, cloud database, software, etc.).

The Controller stores the data subject's data for a period consistent with what the law prescribes and having regard to the time required to correctly achieve the purposes stated above.

To whom do we communicate your personal data?
