



Call for Applications Undergraduate School 2026/2027 Academic Year

Admission with Luiss Test for students with EU/ Schengen citizenship – second session

The test will be held online and remotely; test dates, procedures, technical requirements and behavioral rules are published online on the following [web page](#).

This Call for Applications is dedicated to the admission to the 2026/2027 Academic Year to the following [Degree Programmes offered by the Undergraduate School](#):

1. Requirements and documents for participation

All candidates who have citizenship of a country belonging to the EU or Schengen Area may apply for Luiss Test by May 5th 2026. For submitting the application, it will be necessary:

- a valid **passport or ID card** that clearly indicates citizenship;
- **academic qualification**: candidates must obtain by July 22nd 2026, a secondary school diploma valid for admission to Italian universities, in accordance with the [ministerial requirements](#). In the case of foreign qualifications, the **transcript of records** released by the school of the last **two** years must be attached (in Italian, English or French, in order to verify that the educational pathway is valid for admission to Italian universities, must include:
 - a. the grades, the corresponding school years, and the year of schooling,
 - b. the official stamp of the school,
 - c. the indication of the final academic qualification the student is expected to be obtained.

All applications that do not meet the admission requirements will be automatically discarded.

Application procedure and deadlines

Applications must be submitted exclusively via the platform available on the University website at the following [link](#), **no later than May 5th 2026**.

Before submitting the application, it is necessary to pay the mandatory and non-refundable application fee of €150.00, to be paid exclusively online via the link available on the platform, no later than May 5th 2026.

Please note that each candidate can take the Luiss Test only once and for one Degree Programme only.

Indication of the chosen Degree Programme

While filling out the application, candidates must select the Degree Programme, which will be binding for both admission and enrollment purposes.

If the application is submitted for a Degree Programme taught in Italian, the student is required to take the Luiss Test in Italian; otherwise, for admission to a Degree Programme taught in English, the Luiss Test must be taken in English.

Amending the application

Candidates may request to modify the chosen Degree Programme and amend the information provided in the application at any time before the deadline of May 5th 2026, by emailing the Admission Office: ammissione@luiss.it.

After May 5th 2026, it will not be possible under any circumstances to change the chosen Degree Programme, as this choice is binding for the purposes of admission and subsequent enrolment.

Please note that admission will only refer to the Degree Programme specified in the last version of the application submitted, and the admission will only be valid for the 2026/2027 academic year.

All applications that do not meet the above-mentioned requirements will be automatically discarded.

Candidates acknowledge that the information provided in the application is to be considered a self-certification issued pursuant in accordance with the D.P.R. n. 445 of 28/12/2000 and subsequent amendments. Any false statements will be carried out during the enrollment process. The final verification of the accuracy of the information provided will be carried out during the enrollment process. The annulment of the application does not entitle candidates to the refund of the fee paid.

2. Admission criteria

The admission/non-admission will be determined exclusively based on the score obtained in the Luiss Test. Anonymous rankings, organized by Degree Programme, will be drawn up in order of score, expressed out of one hundredth.

Candidates will be admitted in ranking order until the number of places available for this selection process, as determined by the University and published on the dedicated page of the website.

During the preparation of the ranking lists, the Commission appointed by the Competent University Bodies will verify the recordings related to the tests taken; in the event of any violation of the Regulations and/or the Code of Conduct available on the University website, the candidate will be excluded.

3. Results, Admission and conditions

Candidates may verify the outcome and timeline of the selection by checking the University's website. In case of admission, it will be considered "conditional" and will only be confirmed after verifying that there are no discrepancies between the declared information and that the documentation relating to the completion of the high school diploma qualification is valid for the purposes of admission to Italian universities.

Foreign qualifications

Subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this Call for Application, in the case of academic qualifications awarded under a foreign education systems, admission will also be conditional upon the submission of the documentation requested by the Admission Office for the purpose of verifying the eligibility of the diploma for access to Bachelor's or Single-Cycle Master's Degree Programmes in Italy, in accordance with current regulations.

The list of required documents and the admission requirements for each qualification are published on the following [page](#) of the University website.

If the documentation submitted does not comply with the regulations or with the deadlines for document submission, enrolment will not be permitted under any circumstances, irrespective of admission.

Applicants are reminded that it is their responsibility to verify in advance that their original qualification is valid for admission to bachelor's and single-cycle master's degree programmes in Italy, as well as to fulfil all requirements relating to the issuance of any study visa and to verify what is necessary for access to the University's campuses in accordance with the relevant legislation in force for the year of enrolment.

4. Compensatory measures for candidates with specific learning disorders (SLD) or disabilities

Candidates with Specific Learning Disorders (SLD) or with disability exceeding 66% may apply for the provision of compensatory measures.

This request must be made during the Luiss Test registration process. After selecting the date and time of the test, applicants may indicate their need for compensatory measures by indicating it in the relevant section of the application.

Subsequently, the Admission Office will require the candidate to upload mandatory medical documentation, issued no earlier than 2023. If the required documentation is not uploaded by May 5th 2026, compensatory measures cannot be granted.

The documentation will then be forwarded to and examined by the relevant Committee, which will assess whether to grant compensatory measures in accordance with current regulations.

If the request is approved, the Committee may authorise one or more of the following measures:

- Additional time:
 - +30% of the standard test duration for candidates with SLDs;
 - +50% of the standard test duration for candidates with disabilities.
- Use of a calculator, where applicable;
- Possible support from a reading tutor.

The Admission Office will inform the applicant of the outcome of the assessment and of any compensatory measures granted.

Booking and enrollment

Admitted students must book their enrollment, **by the non-extendable deadline of July 22nd 2026** by paying the first instalment of the annual single tuition fee, amounting to €4,700.00, as well as the regional fee and the stamp duty, for the 2026/2027 academic year, in accordance with the instructions that will be published on the University's website and sent to admitted students.

In the event of failure to enroll by the deadlines specified in this Call for Applications, admission will be discarded.

Finally, it should be noted that in the event of withdrawal, pursuant to the provision set out in Article 27 of Royal Decree No 1269/38, a student who has been admitted, under any circumstances, may be entitled to a refund of the fees, surcharges and contributions paid.

Processing of personal data
