INSTRUCTIONAL GOALS	<p>The course aims to provide students with a comprehensive knowledge of Italian civil procedural law, starting from the study of the fundamental principles of the subject to the analysis of the rules applicable in the ordinary process of cognition as well as in appeal proceedings and before the Court of Cassation.</p> <p>Students will also acquire a thorough understanding of the role of courts, judges and legal professionalisms in the Italian civil justice system.</p>
INTENDED LEARNING OUTCOMES	<p><b>Knowledge and understanding:</b> Students will gain a solid understanding of the fundamental principles, concepts, and procedures of Italian civil procedure law and of the roles of various actors in the civil justice system, including judges, parties, and attorneys.</p> <p><b>Applying knowledge and understanding:</b> Students will be able to apply procedural rules and legal principles to analyse and solve practical problems as well as to use legal reasoning and critical thinking to interpret statutes, regulations, and case law in the context of civil procedure.</p> <p><b>Making judgments:</b> Students will acquire critical-analytical skills to evaluate the strengths and weaknesses of legal arguments presented in civil cases and formulate reasoned judgments.</p> <p><b>Communications Skills:</b> Students will acquire appropriate language and vocabulary and they will be able to communicate their analyses and findings clearly and persuasively, either in writing or orally, regarding the Italian civil procedure law.</p>
