



Code of conduct

Art. 1 – General Principles

The guidelines set out below are a direct application of the Luiss Code of Conduct, promoting the values of loyalty and participation in the light of the social and educational role of the University. In particular, the following indications are set out specifically for the admission test.

Art. 2 – Taking the test

The candidate must:

- Face the test in a serious manner, without external assistance and refraining from using a deceiving behaviour. He/she must respect the Commission and adopt a fair and correct behaviour towards the University;
- Respect the indications shared by the Student Office.

It is forbidden to:

- Use another person's identity or allow other persons to do it in order to satisfy academic requirements or alter one's academic evaluation in any way;
- Allow others to provide any kind of assistance during the test;
- Use any device or other form of assistance during any test, with the only exception of cases expressly authorized by Luiss and communicated before the taking of the test;
- Access any external content, including online resources, during the test.

Art. 3 – Sanctions

Without prejudice to any legal proceeding arising from the disregard of the above mentioned guidelines, violations of the code of conduct will result in the exclusion from the admission test. Luiss reserves the right to exclude from the test those candidates who fail to respect rules and indications set out in the instructions after review of the test registration.

Art. 4 – Final Dispositions

All candidates must know and respect these guidelines, which are published and updated on the University's website.

For anything not included in the guidelines, candidates are invited to be respectful and decent in their behaviour.
