1. **Business Administration:** Organizational Behavior; Financial Markets.
2. **Economics and Management:** Economia dei Mercati e degli Intermediari Finanziari; Statistica Applicata ed Econometria.
3. **Economics & Business:**
 - Major in **Finance:** Capital Markets; Mathematical Finance.
 - Major in **Management:** Entrepreneurship, Innovation and Technology; Management.
 - Major in **Economics:** Economic Growth and Development; Money and Banking.
4. **Global Law:**
 - majors in **Global Law, Business & Tech** and **Global Law and International Organization:** the 4 courses scheduled for each major in the I semester of the III year, Tech Lab **excluded**.
5. **Law:** 2 courses chosen by the student among the 4 compulsory ones envisaged by the major.
6. **Management and Artificial Intelligence:** Databases & Big Data.
7. **Political Science:** Diritto dell'Economia; Metodologia delle Scienze Sociali.

 - Major in **Fundamental Rights Protection:** History of Political Institutions; Multilevel Protection of Fundamental Rights.
 - Major in **Sustainability:** Global Demography; Climate Change and Environmental Sustainability.
 - Major in **Artificial Intelligence:** Law and Ethics of Artificial Intelligence; Artificial Intelligence for Social Impact.
