Study and Reading Rooms Regulations

Users of the study and reading rooms are aware that their behavior should be informed by compliance with the basic rules of respect and responsibility.

The rooms may be used solely for study purposes and to that end users agree:

- 1) **to behave in a manner respectful of the needs of other users and to use the reading rooms properly, cooperating in keeping them clean and in maintaining decorum;**
- 2) **not to bring food and drink into the rooms;**
- 3) **to use only one study station for as long as necessary and not to occupy more than one station or linger in the rooms once they have finished studying;**
- 4) **not to engage in conduct or do anything that may create a risk to persons or property or that may violate applicable laws and regulations;**
- 5) **not to smoke: electronic cigarettes are also expressly prohibited;**
- 6) **not to deface, damage or rearrange the furniture;**
- 7) **not to tamper with the technological equipment in the rooms;**
- 8) **not to tamper with smoke detectors and the video surveillance system;**
- 9) **not to bring or use equipment of any kind other than that routinely permitted for studying;**
- 10) **not to use the rooms for purposes other than those intended.**

Users must also bear the following in mind:

- a) **The canteen dining halls at Viale Pola and Viale Romania are open for study purposes except between 12:30 p.m. and 3 p.m.**
- b) **Mobiles phones may be used solely in silent mode.**
- c) **Distracting noises and shouting are forbidden.**
- d) **University personnel have the right to identify anyone who breaches these Regulations and to demand that they cease their disruptive behavior. Should the warning go unheeded, the user will be removed from the study rooms by the staff in charge.**
- e) **It is recommended that users not leave personal belongings unattended while in the rooms. The University is not liable for any damage, loss or theft.**

Breach of these Regulations will be punished by the academic bodies commensurate with the severity and frequency of the misconduct.
