- Two electives from major International Management (6 ECTS each)
- Two electives (6 ECTS each)
- Internship (8 ECTS)

Plus the credits gained for the final thesis in Luiss: 18 ECTS.

Important Guidelines

- This study plan is designed for students taking part in the mentioned Double Degree Program and spending the academic year 2026/2027 at Paris Dauphine as part of the International Business track.
- Interested students are required to read and understand the study plan and its rules. These are to be considered binding to the successful completion of the double degree program. Changes to the study plan are usually not possible and any request in this sense must be conveyed to the International Degree Programs, that cannot guarantee its feasibility.
- The list of courses taken abroad may be subject to change, should the academic offering at Paris Dauphine be amended.
- The listed exams must be taken and passed in the academic year indicated above. Any possible change to the timeline must be formally authorized by the Academic Commission.
- During the mobility, students will be subject to the rules of Paris Dauphine University.
- At the end of the a.y. 2025/2026, selected students are required to choose the major in International Management.
- At the end of the program, if compliant with both Luiss and Paris Dauphine academic requirements, students will obtain both the Master Management Général Business Transformation MeM (issued by Paris Dauphine) and the Master's Degree in Management (issued by Luiss).
- As explained in the Call for Applications, selected students will be enrolled in the Apprenticeship Track during the mobility at Paris Dauphine. As such, students will combine courses at the partner university with work in a firm. Apprenticeship is compulsory to obtain the Master's Degree issued by Paris Dauphine and, even though Paris Dauphine will provide substantial support, students are the sole responsible to secure an apprenticeship position.
- During the 1st year, selected students will complete a preparatory thesis in English (Memoire), based on a literary review, supported by a Luiss supervisor.
- Courses at Dauphine will be taught in English or in French. Exams will be carried out in the language of instruction of each course.

Thesis Work

- Students will complete the thesis during the second year of the Program (2026/2027) at Paris Dauphine with a supervisor from Luiss. Besides, they will have a supervisor from Paris Dauphine for the Apprenticeship track.
- Both Paris Dauphine and Luiss students are required to comply with the standard procedures of each University regarding thesis assignment, registration for the degree examination, deadlines and thesis upload.
- Each institution will grade the final thesis according to its own standards.
- Students are required to submit the thesis to Paris Dauphine by the end of June of their second year at Paris Dauphine. Both Paris Dauphine and Luiss require an oral defense of the thesis, in accordance with the rules and procedures of each university. At Paris Dauphine, students undertake a one-hour thesis defense, including a Q&A session. Students are prepared for this defense, and a pre-defense is organised in April.
- The earliest graduation session at Luiss for students attending this program (both incoming and outgoing) is the Autumn Session (October-November). Alternatively, students can also graduate in the extraordinary session in March-April.
