# Global Law – Major in Italian Law

## Shortening of program in Law

To Enroll by **shortening of program to the IV year** (A.Y. 2027/2028) of the Single-Cycle Degree in **Law** students must:

- choose the major in Italian Law;
- choose through the Web Self Service and pass in Luiss as **elective courses** Private Law 2 e Labour Law. In the event that one or both electives are taken abroad, it will be necessary to pass them at Luiss as additional courses (these must be included in the study plan by submitting a request to [segreteria@luiss.it](mailto:segreteria@luiss.it) by September 2026;
- choose through the Web Self Service and pass in Luiss as **additional course no weighted average** Civil Procedure Law 2. If the exam is not taken, it will be necessary to complete the Civil Procedural Law integration in the Law degree course.

Grades earned on these additional courses will not be counted in the weighted grade point average, it is not possible to write the final thesis in a subject that you have in the study plan as an additional course and the credits are not eligible for the awarding of the degree in Global Law.

## Core Abroad/Elective Abroad

Should core and/or elective courses be taken abroad in the context of a Double Degree, a Structured Partnership, LLM, an International Exchange Program, the Free Mover Program or a Summer School, the general option Core Abroad and/or Elective Abroad must be selected.

It should be noted that it is necessary that courses have already been approved in accordance with the procedures laid down for every mobility program.

The exam - if passed - will be included in the student's academic record with the awarding of credits for core/elective subjects.

Should the exam for the core and/or elective course taken abroad not be passed it is mandatory to inform the Student Office of the substitute Core Abroad and/or Elective Abroad exam to be taken at Luiss, from among the courses that have been activated and that are not already full.

# Additional Courses

## NON-MANDATORY

- The choice is not compulsory: you can choose 0, 1 or 2 of these courses. If not taken, they can be removed from the study plan.
- If an additional course has been taken and registered in the academic booklet, it cannot be considered among the credits eligible for the awarding of the degree title (basic/core/elective courses or other activities).
- It is not possible to write the thesis on a subject taken as an additional course.

## WEIGHTED GPA

The grade earned in an additional course, **chosen from the list** offered for student's degree program, **is included** in the weighted grade point average in thirtieths.

## EXTRA-LISTA COURSE

It is possible to request the inclusion of extra-lista additional courses (not included in the list of subjects offered for student's specific degree program.).

Grades earned on extra-lista additional courses **will not be counted** in the weighted grade point average.

## Note

If core courses/elective courses/other activities or language courses have already been included in student's career (exams recognized upon transferring from another University/changing degree programs/shortening of program/master, exams taken during mobility, brought forward, etc.), they must be confirmed during the study plan compilation process.

It is not possible to select other courses and take other exams instead of these already recognized or taken.
