



Call for applications for the awarding of twenty-four scholarships to students who hold Italian citizenship or who regardless of their citizenship are studying at a school in Italy and are admitted through the Luiss Test to the first year of a bachelor's degree or single-cycle master's degree programme at Luiss University for the 2025/2026 academic year

Luiss University aims to train new professional figures capable of covering diffused and circular leadership roles, able to respond to digital challenges as well as those in relation to sustainability. The University's education model thus aims to form informed citizens able, through enquiry-based logic, to offer a new perspective in current and future work environments.

To foster the process of selection of the most deserving students, the University announces a competition for the awarding of **twenty-four** scholarships earmarked for students who will enrol at Luiss for the first year of a bachelor's degree or single-cycle master's degree programme in the 2025/2026 academic year.

The scholarships consist of **50% partial tuition fee waivers**, to be credited against the second and third instalments of the University's annual single tuition fee. Therefore, scholarship winners will have to pay the first instalment in full by the deadline that the University sets.

1. Eligibility

The competition is open to students who hold Italian citizenship or who regardless of their citizenship are studying at a school in Italy and are admitted through the Luiss Test to the first year of a bachelor's degree or single-cycle master's degree programme at Luiss University for the 2025/2026 academic year. That category includes students admitted after passing the admission test taken during the 2024 Summer School.

2. Submission of Applications

Applications to participate in this competition must be submitted, through an online application form, **between 15 May 2025 and noon on 20 June 2025**. Students awaiting the outcome of their application for university admission may also apply.

The application form must be accompanied by a copy of an ISEE means test certificate (***Indicatore della Situazione Economica Equivalente***), valid as at the deadline for the submission of applications for this present competition and calculated in accordance with current legislation on aid for university studies, without omissions or discrepancies. **Applications that attach a DSU declaration (*Dichiarazione Sostitutiva Unica*) instead of an ISEE certificate will not be taken into consideration.**

Should the student's family earn solely foreign income and hence be unable to apply for the issuance of an Italian ISEE certificate, the means test value will be calculated directly by the University on the basis of the self-certification given by the student regarding the composition of their family unit as well as the income and assets owned by that family unit abroad in the year 2023. The self-certification must be issued using the form attached as Annex 1 to this Call for Applications and must be written in Italian or English, failing which the student will be excluded from the competition.

Upon submission of the application online, candidates will receive a confirmation of the sending of the application at their e-mail address. If the confirmation e-mail is not received, candidates should contact the Financial Aid Office by sending an e-mail to financialaid@luiss.it.

Only complete applications actually received by the deadline will be considered. Luiss University disclaims any liability in relation to applications that are not received due to technical issues or reasons attributable to third parties.

3. Criteria for Awarding the Aid

The aid will be awarded in order of ranking established on the basis of the following criteria:

- up to a maximum of 30 points on the basis of economic situation (ISEE means test value);
- up to a maximum of 70 points on the basis of the score obtained in the admission test valid for enrolment at Luiss University.

In the event of a tie, preference will be accorded to the student with the lowest ISEE means test value calculated for the purposes of obtaining aid for university studies.

The outcome of the application will be published in each candidate's own personal area by the month of June 2025.

4. Renewal of the Aid in Subsequent Years

The partial tuition fee waiver may be renewed for the entire standard duration of the degree programme on condition that the recipient student, by the end of the summer exam session of each year, has earned at least 70% of the ECTS credits required under their study plan for graduation purposes and also has a weighted average grade of not less than 27/30.

The end of the summer session is set annually by the University and does not include the month of September.

5. Incompatibility

The aid envisaged by this competition is incompatible with other tuition fee waivers or scholarships held for any reason whatsoever, except for those awarded by Italian or foreign institutions designed to support, through periods abroad, a student's education for the academic years covered by this competition.

Should the student participate in an international mobility programme while remaining the holder of a scholarship during the period of study abroad, the student will not be able to enjoy a full exemption if the host university does not have a reciprocal relationship with Luiss University. Therefore, all expenses inherent in participation in the mobility programme will have to be borne by the student.

6. Revocation

The aid envisaged by this competition will be revoked upon the occurrence of any one of the following:

- the student fails to enrol at Luiss University for the 2025/2026 academic year;
- the student enrolls as a repeat or off-track student;
- the student discontinues their studies;
- the student transfers to another university;
- the student no longer fulfils the requirements necessary for renewal, as specified in the preceding Article 4.

7. Checking of Documentation

The documentation submitted with the applications will be checked and should there be a discrepancy between what has been stated and what is actually the case, the aid granted will be revoked and action will be taken in accordance with law.
